Payments to School

Payments are made to school via our online payment system, ParentPay.

At the New Parents/Carers' Evening, we will issue you with online login details and instructions to be used to set up an account. This can be linked into any ParentPay accounts you may have for your other children already at Bredon Hill Academy.

School Meals

School meals are made on site in the school kitchens. The menus for each week are available here. From September meals will cost £3.50 which includes a cooked meal or a baguette or pasta pot, a drink and a pudding. Please make all meal payments through ParentPay. ParentPay allows you to make a lump sum payment. There is no requirement to tell us on which day your child will require a lunch; their balance will simply be reduced each day that they take a meal. Within the ParentPay system, you will be able to set up an alert to inform you when this balance is running low.
